iscipline is one of the most important issues in every classroom throughout the world. Although disciplinary rules differ depending on the country, the purpose behind them is largely the same: to ensure safety in the classroom and to create a comfortable learning environment. Most education experts agree that it is necessary to establish these rules - and the punishments for breaking them - from the very beginning. Creating and posting a rule list, for example, is an easy way to teach students acceptable classroom behavior. It is just as important for teachers to enforce these rules as it is for students to adhere to them. If teachers are not prepared to follow their own rules, then such a list becomes simply a collection of meaningless words. Other academic thinkers believe that it is important to increase positive behavior in the classroom by creating a comfortable, happy atmosphere. Rewards, praises and even smiles can help students feel proud, relaxed and secure, and could perhaps stop problems before they start.

Unfortunately, establishing guidelines and promoting positive behavior are not always effective. Disruptive behavior, and even violence, can and do happen in even the most guarded schools. Many parents and teachers believe that school officials are restricted from effectively punishing problem students. Unlike Japan, physical contact between students and teachers in American schools is largely prohibited, and some students have won court cases because they felt they were being unfairly punished. Many people believe that these rules and events have made educators afraid and unable to properly enforce school rules, causing an increase in unwanted classroom behavior.
