From my apartment on the first floor, I heard a loud **thump** which came directly from the second floor. It was my **neighbor**, and she was in a lot of pain. She called for help from her second floor apartment and so I called the **ambulance** and then went to see what was wrong.

She said that her stomach was hurting and she **begged** me to call a doctor for her. After I called the ambulance, we realized that the ambulance company and the police department didn't know where we lived because the apartment complex was just built.

All departments didn't even have a map of our apartment complex. It was a very **scary** situation.

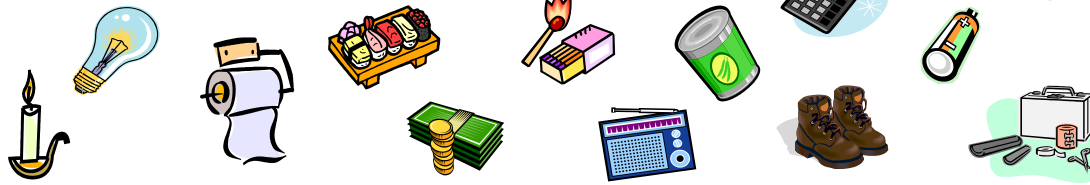

# Emergency Kit

～ 72時間サバイバルキット ～

カナダでは、災害時の個人レベルでの対策として、72時間分の水や食料などの必需品を用意しておくべきと呼びかけが行われています。カナダでの必需品が書かれている英文を読んで、該当する正しいアイテム13個にマルをつけて下さい。

- Water. at least two liters of water per person per day
- Food that won't spoil, such as canned and dried foods
- Manual can opener
- Flashlight and batteries
- Candles and matches or lighter
- Battery-powered or wind-up radio (and extra batteries)
- First aid kit & prescription medications
- Some cash and change for payphones
- A change of clothing and footwear
- Toilet paper and other personal care supplies

**Look out!** あぶない!!気をつける!

**Move it!** どけ!それを動かせ!

**Stand back!** そこだけ!さがれ!

**(Get your) hands off!** 手を離せ!はわるな!

**(Get your) hands up!** 手を挙げる!

**Cut it out! / Cut that out!** やめる!

**Watch out!** 危ない!!気をつける!
