Ingredients

- |   |   |
|---|---|
| 1/2 cup cream cheese/mayonnaise                 | 4 <b>teaspoons</b> brown mustard                  |
| 1/2 cup dried cranberries                       | 1/4 cup <b>chopped</b> walnuts, <b>if desired</b> |
| 1/ <b>tsp</b> ground cinnamon                   | 1 large apple, <b>cored</b> , cut in 8 rings      |
| 8 slices Whole Wheat Bread, toasted, if desired |   |
| 4 leaves curly leaf lettuce                     | 3/4 pound thinly sliced Turkey <b>Breast</b>      |

**Cheese Spread:** In small bowl, mix together cream cheese, mustard, dried cranberries, walnuts and cinnamon.

**sandwiches:** Spread each slice of bread with cream cheese spread. Top 4 slices with lettuce leaves, turkey and apple rings. Complete sandwich with remaining bread.
