1/2 cup dried cranberries 1/4 cup chopped walnuts, if desired

1/tsp ground cinnamon 1 large apple, cored, cut in 8 rings

8 slices Whole Wheat Bread, toasted, if desired

4 leaves curly leaf lettuce 3/4 pound thinly sliced Turkey Breast

Cheese Spread: In small bowl, mix together cream cheese, mustard, dried cranberries, walnuts and cinnamon.

sandwiches: Spread each slice of bread with cream cheese spread. Top 4 slices with lettuce leaves, turkey and apple rings. Complete sandwich with remaining bread.
